Colossians 1:24-28 – 16th Sunday Ordinary Time "The Captivity Epistles" St. Paul was a prolific writer. He is attributed with writing fourteen

of the twenty-one letters in the New Testament (excluding the Gospels). From very early in Church history four of St. Pauls' letters – Ephesians, Philippians, Philemon and Colossians (from which today's second reading comes), were known as the "Captivity Epistles" because they were written while Paul was in prison. Given that St. Paul was imprisoned in Ephesus, Caesarea, and Rome no one is sure whether these letters were all written from the same place. Paul's letter to the Colossians is addressed to a congregation

pressured to adopt false doctrines. Paul commended the community as a whole, expressed his prayerful concern for them, and assured the Colossians that Christ possess the sum total of redemptive power.
