FROM THE PASTOR

Luke 3:15-16, 21-22—Baptism of the Lord
"Symbols of the Holy Spirit"

In today's Gospel we learn Jesus will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire (v16). Fire symbolizes the Holy Spirit and the transforming power and energy of the Spirit's actions. Jesus came to "to cast fire upon the earth" (Lk 12:49); that fire is the Holy Spirit. Anointing with oil is another symbol of the Spirit. Jesus is the Christ, the "anointed One", but anointed with what? In the sacrament of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy orders is a symbol which affects something spiritual which is not seen. The real anointing is with the Holy Spirit. As "by one Spirit we were all baptized," so we are also "made to drink of one Spirit" (1Cor 12:13). And when Jesus was baptized the Holy Spirit, in the form of a dove, came down upon Him and remains with Him, just as the Spirit remains in the purified hearts of the baptized (CCC 696-701)
