FROM THE PASTOR

Acts 1:11-Ascension/7th Sunday of Easter

"Ascension"

The Mystery of the Ascensions has three distinct aspects. First is the glorification of Jesus. In his human nature Jesus passes to the state of glory and is reunited with his Father and the Holy Spirit, signified by "the cloud" (Acts 1:9), a biblical sign of the Divine presence. Jesus takes possession of the Kingdom he won through his death to prepare a place for us in heaven (Rev 3:21f) and to send the Holy Spirit to his Church. Second, the Ascension brings to completion Jesus' visible ministry on earth and the beginning of the kingdom of the Messiah. Third, Jesus is Lord of eternal life. By his Cross and Resurrection of Jesus has opened the gates of heaven for us, "now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf" (Heb 9:12). In his risen body Jesus showed himself to his disciples and then he was taken up to heaven, in their sight, to claim for us a share in his divine life.
