#### THE SEASON OF LENT

“Lent is ordered to preparing for the celebration of Easter, since the Lenten liturgy prepares for celebration of the Paschal Mystery both catechumens, by the various stages of Christian Initiation, and the faithful, who recall their own Baptism and do penance. The forty days of Lent run from Ash Wednesday up to but excluding the Mass of the Lord’s Supper exclusive. From the beginning of Lent until the Paschal Vigil, the *Alleluia* is not said.

#### ABSTINENCE

All Catholics who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on the following days: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

#### FASTING

All Catholics between their 18<sup>th</sup> and 59<sup>th</sup> birthday are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on the following days: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of a day.

#### EASTER DUTY

After being initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, the faithful are bound to receive Communion at least once a year. During the Easter Season. (February 21, 2021 to May 30, 2021)

### FROM THE PASTOR

Mark 1:40-45 – 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### “Compassion and Forgiveness”

In Jesus’ time leprosy was seen as a curse from God (Num 12:10-15), while the disappearance of the disease was a great blessing (35:8; Mt 11:5). Because leprosy was contagious the Law declared lepers impure and unclean requiring them to live outside the city (Num5:2, 12:14). They were totally ostracized and forgotten, On this particular day a leper approached Jesus in clear violation of the Law. The passage show us the faithful and confident prayer of a man need Jesus” help and begging Him for it, confident that, if Jesus chose, He could cure him from the disease (Mt 8:2). Jesus was “moved with pity, he stretched out his hand and touched him” (v41), and the leper was cured. Often times we find ourselves at odds and separated from one another. Sometimes it is our doing, but we may find I difficult to forgive and overcome those problems. With a prayer to Jesus and the aid of the Sacrament of Reconciliation we can reach out and be cleansed of those things that hinder true fellowship in our families, parish, city, etc.
