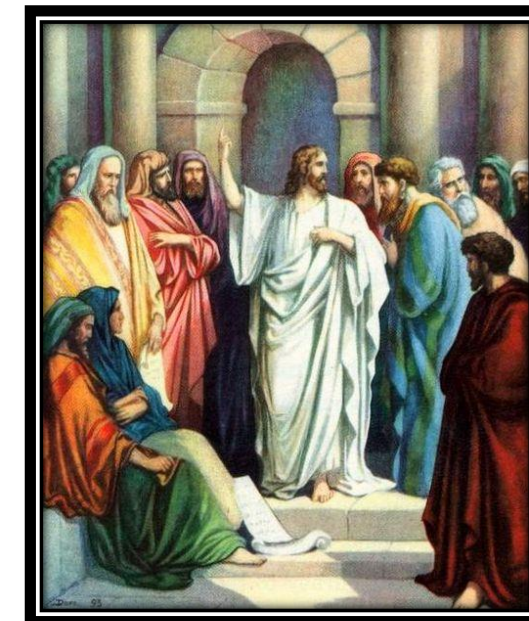

FROM THE PASTOR

2 Cor 12:7-10-14th Sunday Ordinary Time

In today's second reading our Lord says, "My grace is sufficient for you..." (v9), but what is grace? "Grace is favor, the free and undeserved help that God gives us to respond to his call..." (CCC1996). As food nourishes the body, so grace nourishes the soul. Grace is aimed at enabling us to share in God's own life; through it we become "partakers in the divine nature" (2Pet 1:4), able to live the Christian life, remain faithful to the Ten Commandments and the commandments of love. Prayer, too, is the work of grace, for only in the Spirit that we can pray fruitfully (Rom 8:26-27). Grace is central to all of Catholic life. To present what faith teaches about grace is to present to the whole mystery of Christ, the whole story of salvation, "for by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God" (Eph 2:8). Those who seek to please God must make us of the means of grace that deepens that deepens our relationship with the Lord, namely the sacraments, prayers, and works of love.

*Father of all nations and ages,
we recall the day when our country claimed its place among the family of nations; for what has been achieved we give you thanks, for the work that remains we ask your help, and as you have called us from many peoples to be one nation, grant that, under your providence, our country may share your blessings with all the peoples of the earth. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.*

World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly in late January 2021, Pope Francis announced he would establish "World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly." To be sure, some of our "most faithful" are counted among them, as we explore this model of Saint Joseph this month. This year, for the celebration, the Pope has invited us to realize the closeness of God and of the Church to every older person, through the lens of the gospel theme, "I am with you always" from Mathew. "I am with you always" is also a promise of closeness and hope that young and old can mutually share. Not only are grandchildren and young people called upon to be present in the lives of older people, but older people and grandparents also have a mission of evangelization, proclamation and prayer, and of encouraging young people in their faith. This day will be celebrated each year on the fourth Sunday of July to coincide with the Feast of Ss. Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents.
