FROM THE PASTOR

Mathew 28:16-20-Trinity Sunday

In today's Gospel Jesus addresses His apostles with the majesty proper to God: "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me" (v18). Omnipotence, an attribute to belonging exclusively to God, belongs to Jesus. By these words Jesus confirms the faith of His worshippers, and He is also telling them that the authority which He is going to give them so they can carry out their mission to the world (v19-20), derives from His own divine authority. The Church and all the faithful have the duty to proclaim until the end of time, by word and example, the faith they have received. The Church must faithfully express the mind and will of Christ. On hearing these words of Our Lord, we should bear in mind that the authority of the Church, given for the salvation of mankind, comes directly from Jesus, and that this authority, when dealing with faith and/or morals, is above any other authority on earth. The teachings of the Pope and of the Bishops united to him must always be accepted by Catholics with assent and obedience.
