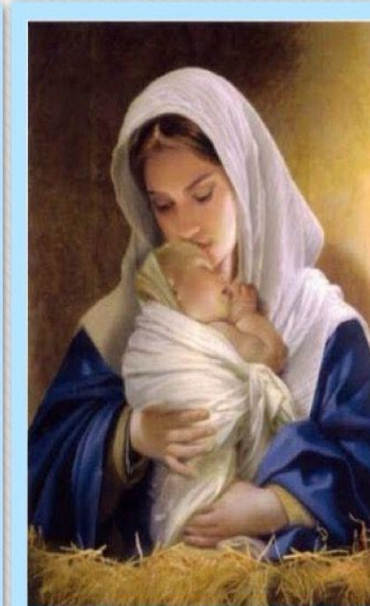

FROM THE PASTOR

John 10:27-30 -4th Sunday of Easter
"The Divinity of Jesus"

In today's Gospel Jesus reveals that He and the Father are one in substance: "I and the Father are one" (v30). In 318 AD the heresy of Arianism, led by an Alexandrian priest named Arius, denied the truth of Christ's divinity and that He is the eternal Son of God. Arius believed Jesus was a creature and that there are not three distinct persons in God, but only one person, the Father. At the Council of Nicea the Church further developed its Creed which declared, in opposition to the Arian view that Jesus is a creature, "God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten not made..." At Nicea the Church adopted the term "homoousias" ("One in Being with the Father") to express the co-equality and co-eternity of the Son with the First Person of the Trinity.
