podcast coming up called Cathechism in a Year.

This brand new podcast features the Catechism of the Catholic Church in bite size portions every single day for a full year; learning about the fundamentals of our faith and why they matter to us, and learning about how rooted the Catechism is within Scripture and also 2000 years of Sacred Traditions.

Our world is so often saturated with a Godless culture. Why not steep our minds with one or two holy books of our faith, the Scripture and the Catechism?
