The Mass is the highest form of prayer in the Church, and the most effective prayer that could be said on behalf of those who have gone before us. In Masses for the dead, and especially funeral Masses, "the Church offers the Eucharistic sacrifice of Christ's Pasch for the dead so that, since all the members of Christ's Body are in communion with one another, what implores spiritual help for some, may bring comforting hope to others." ("General Instruction of the Roman Missal," 379)

**CATECHISM 101 (FOR EVERYONE)**

**Why do we have to go to Mass?**

**God doesn't have to love us as a Father: he freely chooses to do so. Nor did he "have to" give us his only Son to die for our sins and grant us the possibility of eternal life. God's creativity is outdone only by his generosity.**

**So rather than asking why we should go to Mass, here is the question we should be asking: "Is God worth it?" Is taking one hour set aside to let God love us while we try to love him worth it? Do we think created things are more important than the One who created them?**

**Everything we have is a gift from God—every blessing in our lives, every person, talent, ability, and interest --every good gift. The Mass is the greatest gift God gives us. When we come to be more aware of our own sins and our need for a savior, the more clearly we see the Mass as not merely an obligation but an opportunity not to be missed.**

**Please, especially during this time in our world be sure to attend Mass at least once a week either in person, online, or on EWTN. Spend some time with your Father who loves you. He delights in you!**
