NOTICE THAT, On February 28, 2020, The Diocese of Buffalo N.Y., ("Diocese") filed
for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy
Code").

The Bankruptcy Court has established August 14, 2021, at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing
Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the "Bar
Date").

If you have a claim against the Diocese, including, without limitation, a claim
related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese,
you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date.

FROM THE PASTOR

2 Corinthians 5:6-10—11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Particular Judgement"

What happens to the soul at death? Some say the body and
soul "sleep" in the grave until the end of the world. But the
Church has constantly taught that while the body remains in
the grave until the Final Judgment. Each individual soul will
appear before God immediately after death to render an
account to our Lord for all that we have done, "whether good
or evil" (2 Cor 5:10) to receive judgement. This is called the
"Particular Judgement" and while this teaching is not explicitly
defined in Scripture it is certainly implied. "Just as it is
appointed that human beings die once, and after this the
judgement" (Heb 9:27). In today's second reading St. Paul
expresses a desire to die and to be with Christ (2 Cor 5:6-9);
also, Phil 1:23; Lk 16:22-23; Lk23:43). This sentence of
reward or punishment given at the judgment will be ratified at
the general judgment at the end of time which will manifest to
the world God's justice and His mercy.
