## FROM THE PASTOR

### John 20:19-23-Pentecost

The Church has dogmatically defined that the normal means for forgiving sins committed after baptism is through the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). However, the power to forgive sins does not come only from Christ, for Jesus received it from His Father. Just as Jesus was sent by the Father to reconcile the world to God, Jesus sent the Apostles to continue this mission. Jesus said, "As the Father has sent Me, so I send you." (Jn 20:21). The apostles were to forgive sins just as Jesus did. How do we know this? Read the very next verse: "whose sins you forgive they are forgiven them, whose sins you retain they are retained" (v22-23). How would the apostles know which sins to forgive or retain unless the sinner first confessed his sins? By these words Jesus expressly passed on His power to forgive sins to His apostles and their successors, the future caretakers of the Church. Some may find it uncomfortable or difficult to go to Confession, but our task is to obey God, not question His ways. Going to Confession reconciles us with God and the Church, restores us to God's grace, and gives us peace and serenity of conscience.
