**Lent**

The last few weeks we have given ideas on how to prepare for Lent. The first is we must show up! **Go to Mass and Confession! Ask for that forgiveness you need. Spend time with the Lord on Sunday during Mass.**

Last week, we offered a **Lenten Companion Retreat by Ascension Press**. Even if you do not have time to journal. You can always find time to look at the videos. Go to [ascensionpress.com](http://ascensionpress.com) and look for **The Lenten Companion Year C**.

This week we will discuss a few guidelines for Lent.

**Abstinence-** All Catholics between their 18<sup>th</sup> and 59<sup>th</sup> birthdays are bound to abstain totally from meat on the following days. Ash Wednesday, All Fridays during Lent and Good Friday. Now is a suitable time to start planning for those meatless meals! We don't want to stress about Friday meals.

**Fasting-** All Catholics between their 18<sup>th</sup> and 59<sup>th</sup> birthdays are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on the following days: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken in the course of a day.

**FROM THE PASTOR**

**Luke 6:17, 20-26 – 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday Ordinary Time**  
**"The Beatitudes – A Call to Holiness."**

The Beatitudes contain the essence of Jesus' teaching. They are not merely a warning to avoid evil actions that are hostile to love and peaceful living. Christ lived a perfect human life, and in the Beatitudes, He invites us to adopt His way of life. The beatitudes put spiritual good on a much higher plane. Then material possessions by calling us to be new people living in a new way. Reflection on the Beatitudes reminds us that Christian lives cannot settle peacefully into mediocrity. God calls all of us to lives of holiness (CCC 2013). Thus, the Beatitudes are first of all portraits of Christ Himself (CCC 1717). They demonstrate the many facets of His infinite love and mercy and the way in which Christ wishes our lives to be like His. Those who live the Beatitudes are happy in the goodness of their lives. They have secure confidence of possessing a blessed homeland in the kingdom of heaven.

**St. Joseph's Table**

The year of St. Joseph has ended, but we would like to honor him on his Feast Day on **Saturday March 19, 2022**. Fr. Piotr will celebrate Mass and we will recite the Litany of St. Joseph together. After Mass we would like to have a St. Joseph's table for all. We are aware that Covid is still a concern, but we are hoping by March we can safely gather as a parish to celebrate this special day. We will have a sign-up sheet in the narthex of both churches starting this weekend, to see what kind of interest we have in the spaghetti dinner. You must reserve ahead of time as we will not be doing walk-ins on that day.

The origins of St. Joseph's Table can be traced to the Middle Ages. According to one tradition, during a famine brought on by a severe drought, starving villagers-many of them farmers-prayed to St. Joseph, asking for his intercession. St. Joseph helped them to survive by eating the Fava Bean. It was the only crop that would grow in such harsh conditions. So bountiful the crop became that the famine ended. To offer their thanks the people prepared a special feast, inviting the poor and less fortunate among them to share in the meal. The Feast of St. Joseph's Table has been celebrated ever since.
