John 15-9-17—6th Sunday in Easter

“Theological Virtues—Faith, Hope, and Love”

In today’s Gospel as Jesus sat at table with His disciples, He knew this would be their last evening together. Of all the things he could have said, He decided to tell them of His Father’s love. The theological virtues are faith, hope, and love. Together with sanctifying grace God infuses the soul with these virtues at Baptism, so that, having become children of God, we may do the works of God. “So, faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love” (1 Cor 13:13). These virtues give us the power to believe God Himself with a personal and living faith, to have an entire trust in Him, and to love Him with sincere hearts. Exercising these virtues in our daily lives makes them stronger and more deeply rooted in our souls. We can do this by making free and deliberate acts of faith, hope and love. In all those who share in God’s own life by grace, God gives the power to perform the saving acts of believing and trusting and loving Him.
